

NOTICE OF COMPLETION AND AVAILABILITY
DRAFT PROGRAM ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT (Draft PEIR)
CITY OF LOS ANGELES SOLID WASTE INTEGRATED RESOURCES PLAN (SWIRP)

Proposed Project: The City of Los Angeles has developed the Solid Waste Integrated Resources Plan (SWIRP) a long-range plan for the City's solid waste management needs through 2030. SWIRP identifies the policies, programs and facilities that will be needed to reach the City's goal of 90 percent landfill diversion by 2025.

Significant Environmental Effects of Project: SWIRP, which is a Master Plan with no site specific development proposed at this time, identifies the potential future development of 10 to 15 facilities that would address the City's solid waste infrastructure needs through 2030 (one large or six small composting facilities, three clean material recovery facilities, one resource recovery center for self-haul materials, and five alternative technology facilities for treating residual waste). The analysis in the Draft PEIR identified potentially significant impacts, including impacts to aesthetics and visual resources, agricultural and forestry resources, biological and cultural resources, geology and soils, hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, land use and planning, mineral resources, noise, population and housing, public services and recreation. All of these impacts could be mitigated to below a level of significance. There are also some potentially significant, unmitigable air quality and traffic impacts related to the construction and operation of solid waste facilities at the program level of analysis.

Public Review Period: The Draft PEIR is available for public review from October 31, 2013 to December 20, 2013.
